

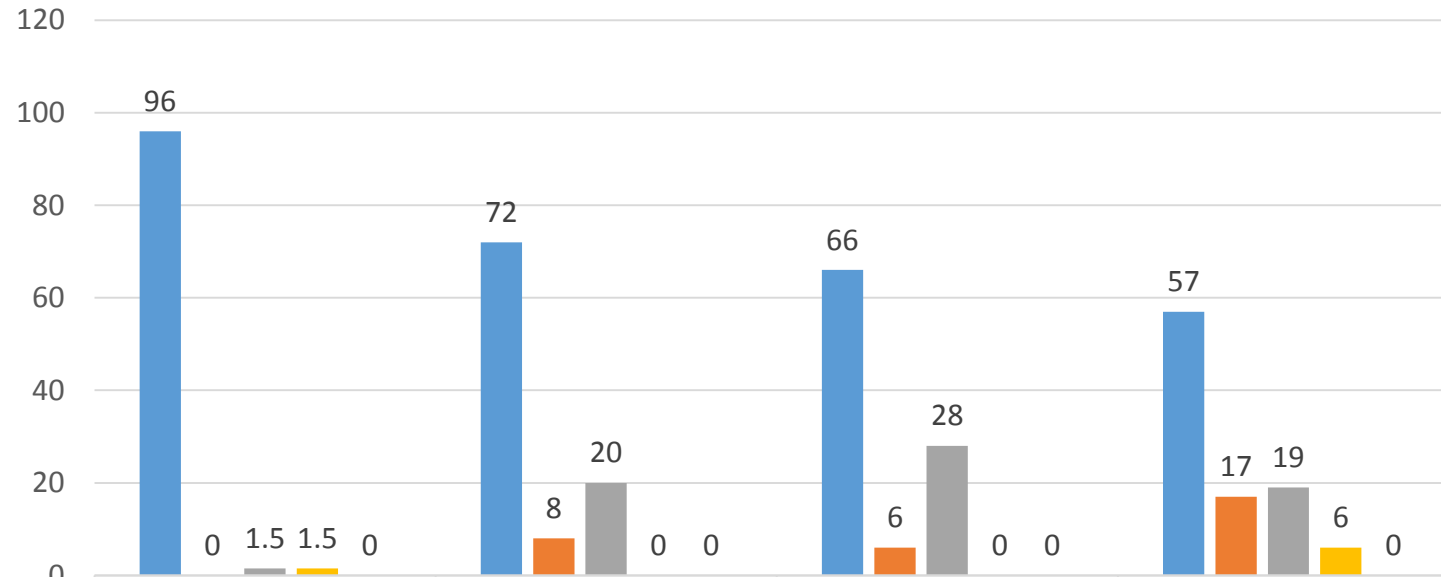

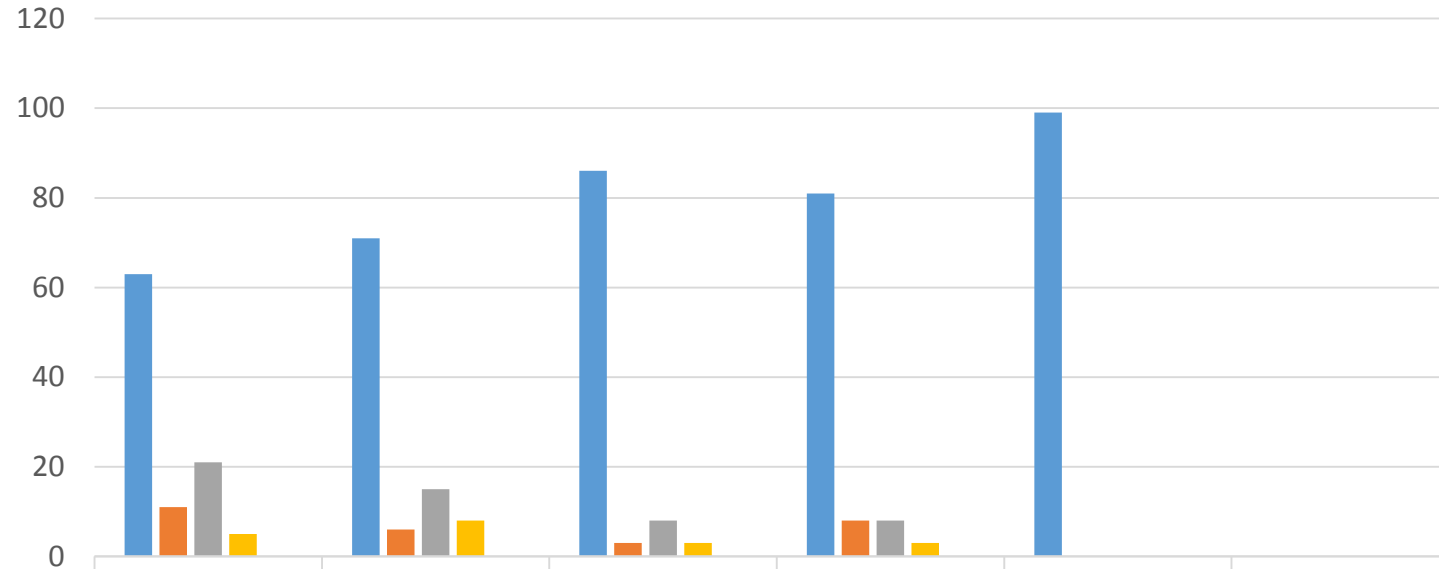

1. In your opinion, do the following examples represent corruption?



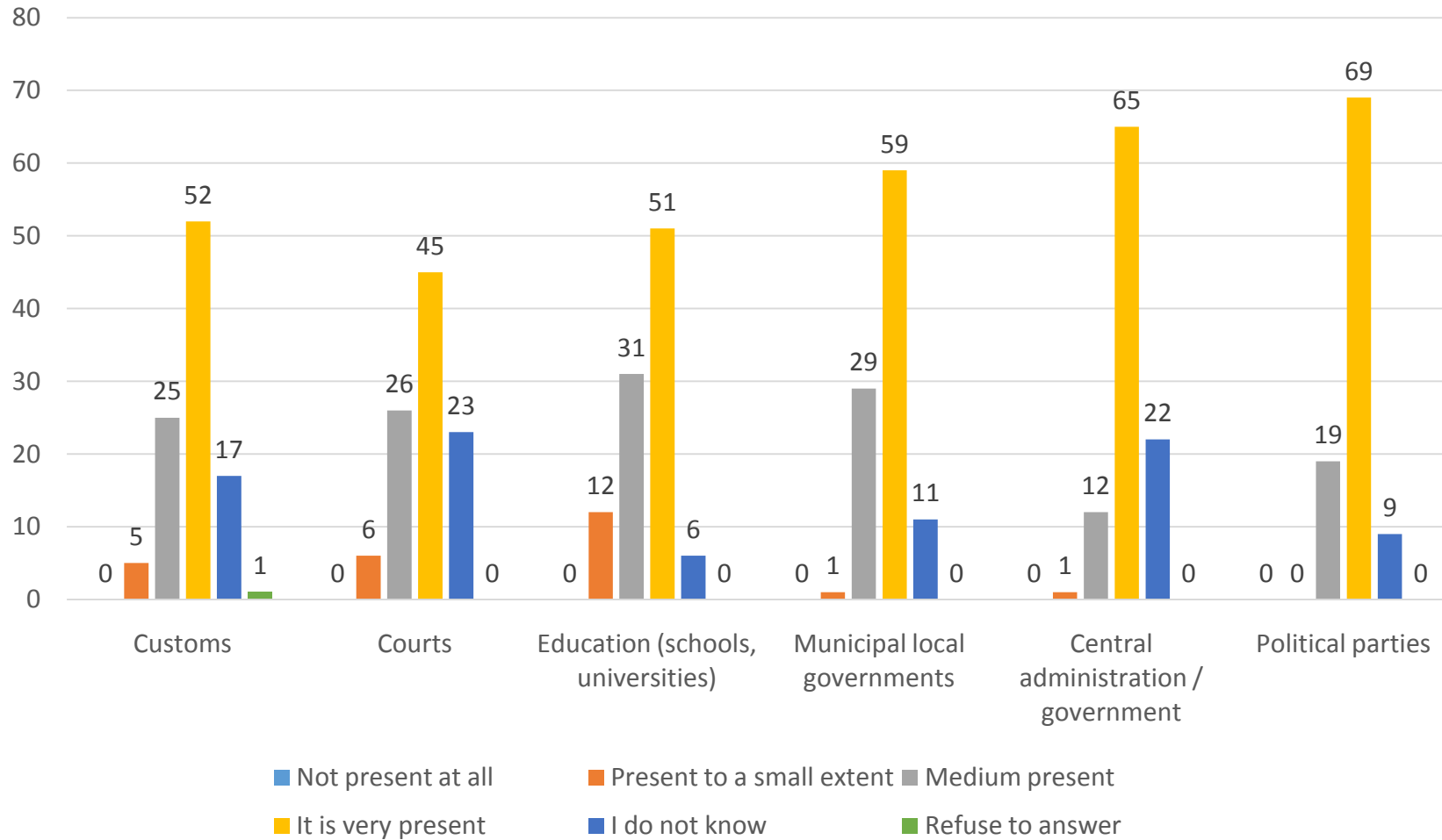

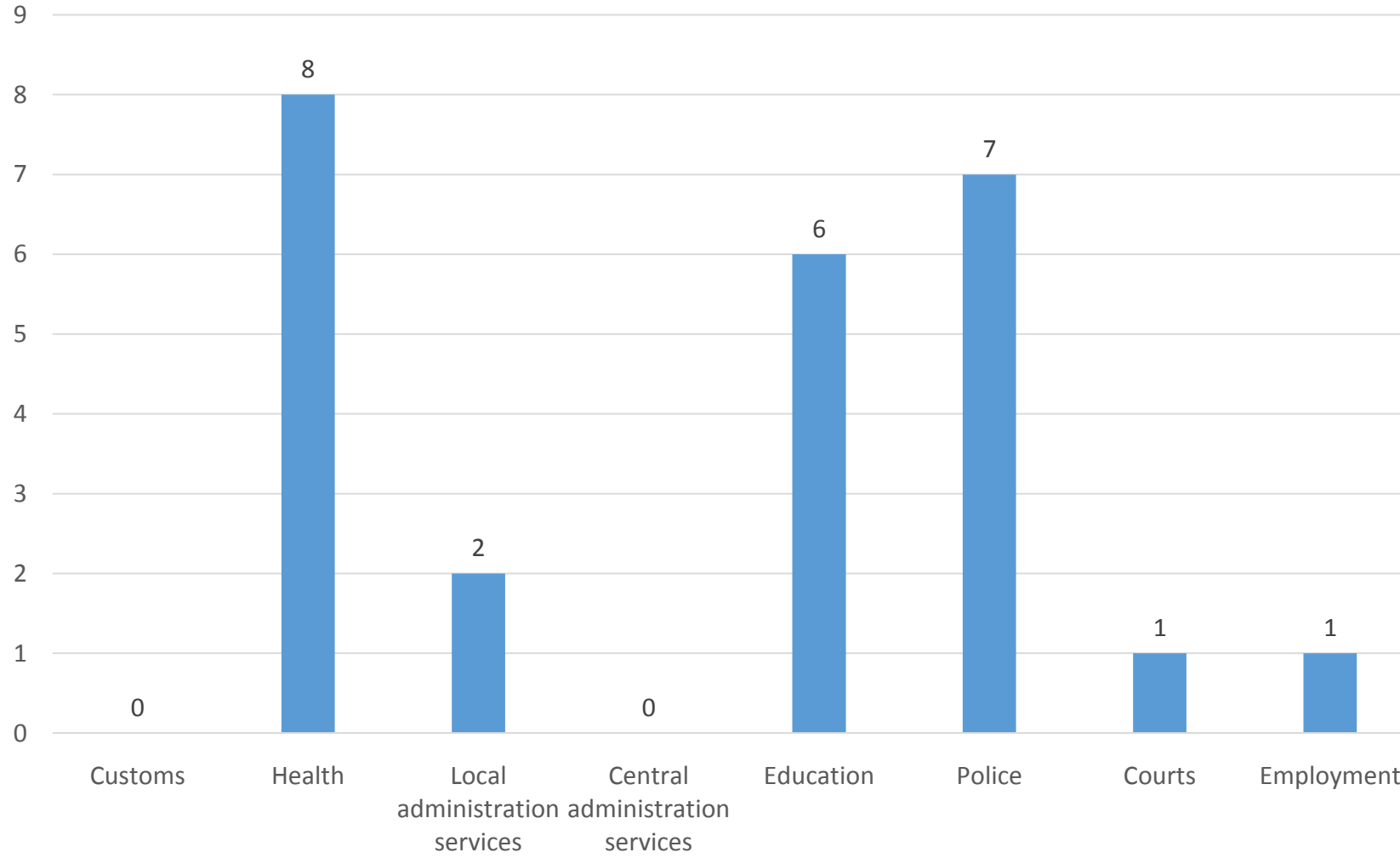
4. During the last year, have you been in a position that a Civil Servant conditioned you for performing one of his duties by asking for a bribe, gift or any other favor?



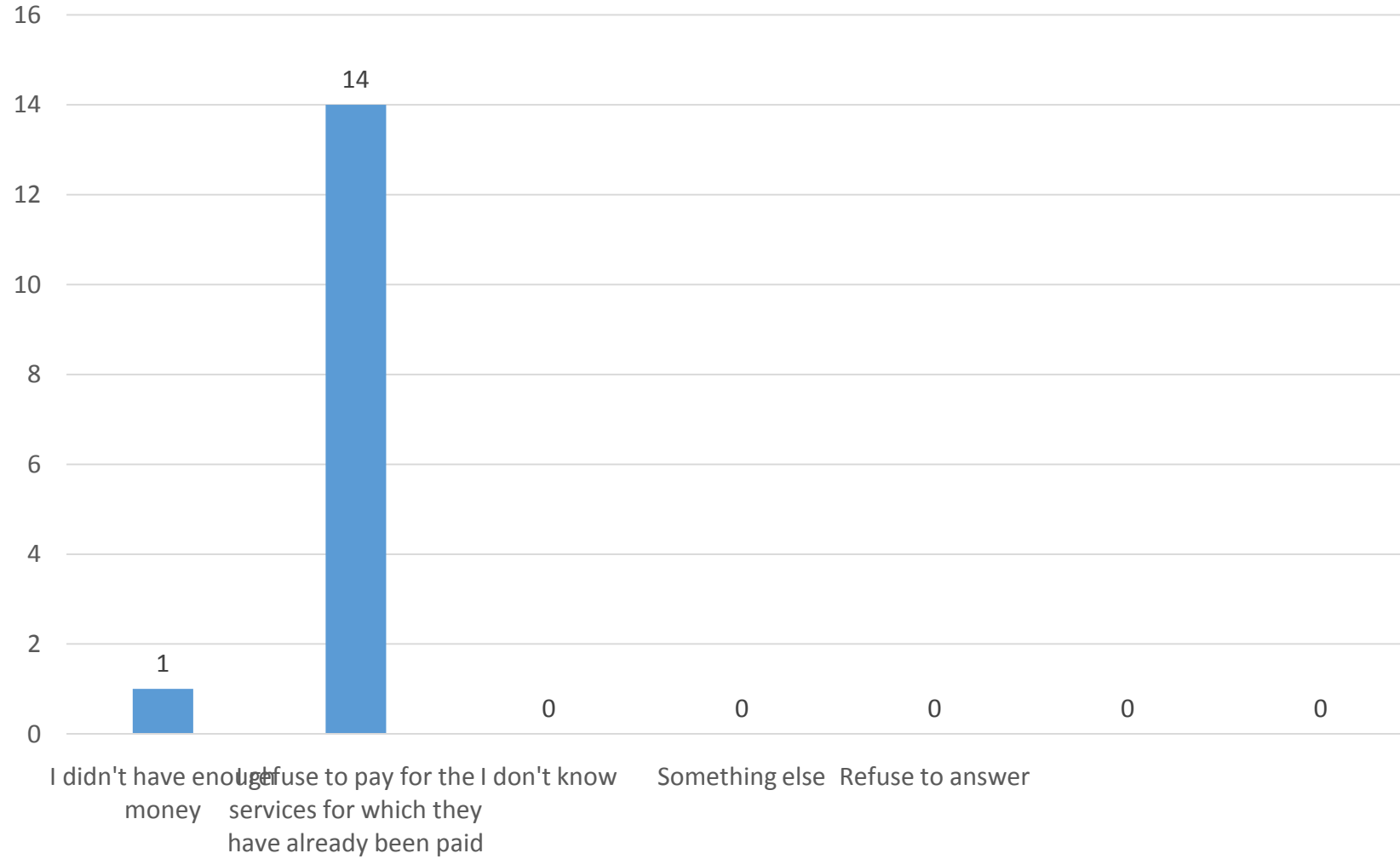

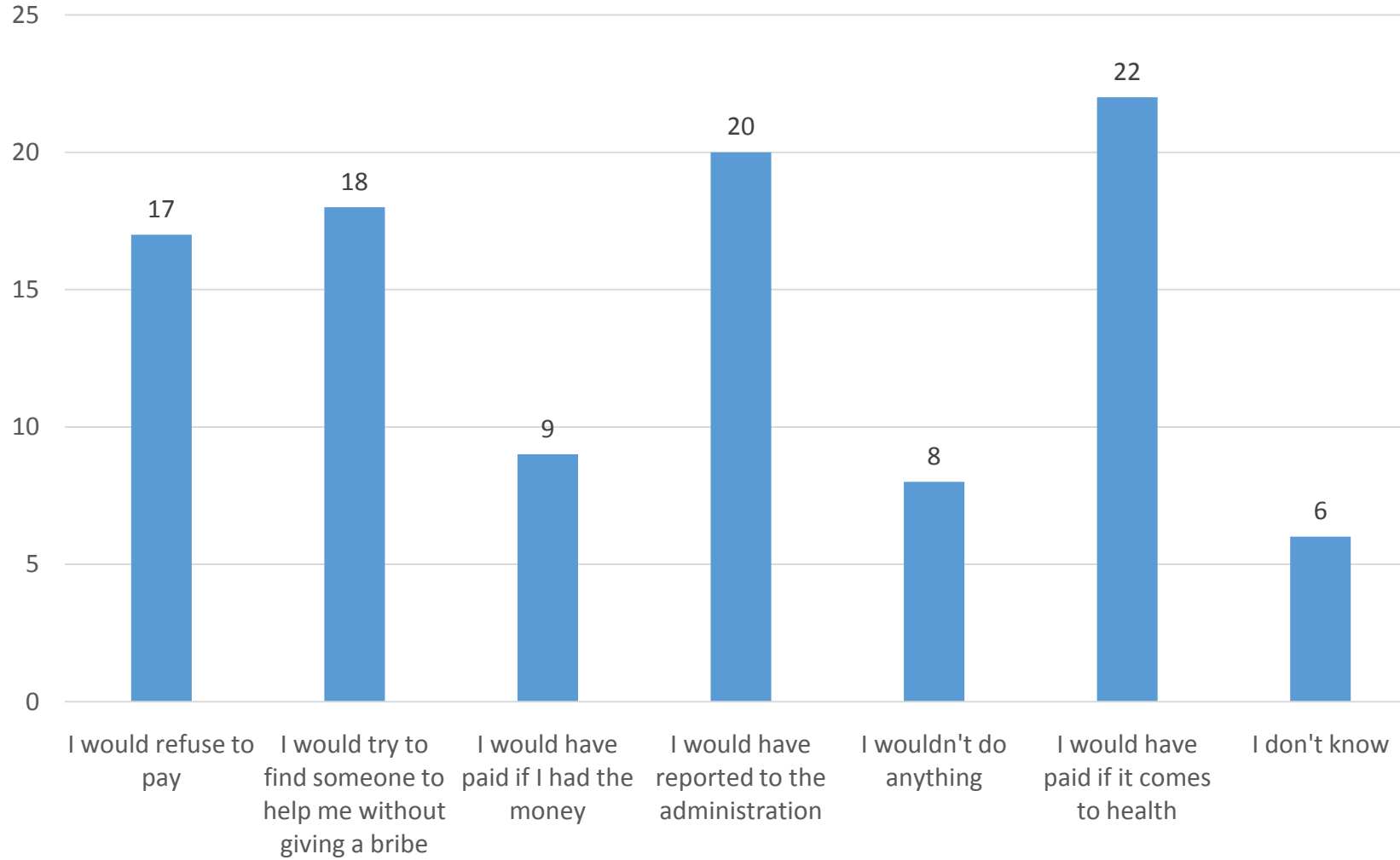

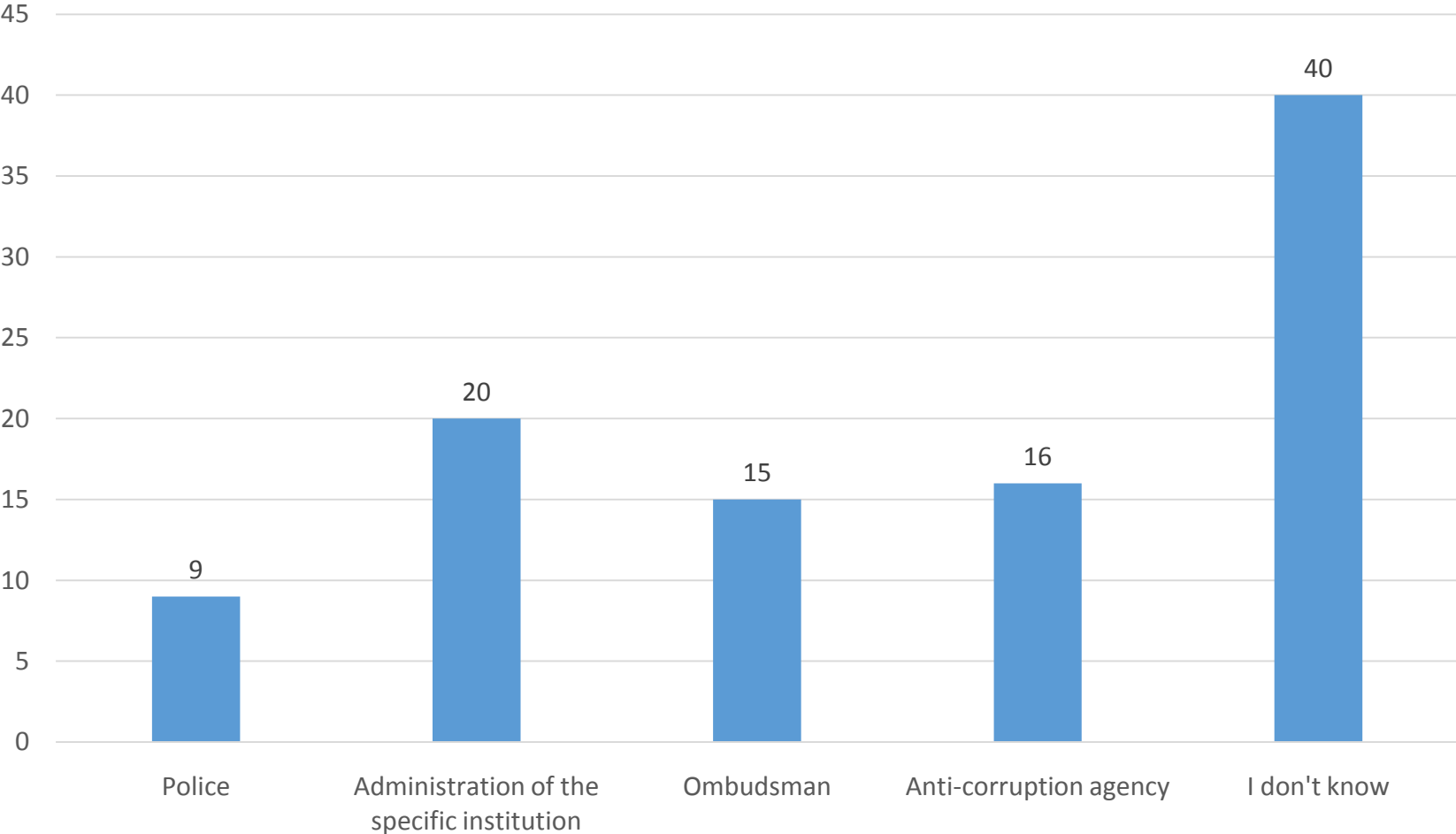
