




Target group and general information regarding the survey


- Current students of the University in North Mitrovica

Do you feel safe while spending your free time in the student complex at night?




If you do not feel safe in the student complex at night, please explain why.

The most common responses:


- Frequent attacks

- -Suspicious individuals


How often do you go out?

Do you feel safe in the places where you go out?




If you do not feel safe in the places where you go out, please explain why.


Most common responses:

Please circle or write in which locations in your opinion are the least safe in the city.






Have you or someone you know experienced threats, attacks or theft in the locations mentioned above?




In your opinion would adequate lighting and presence of police patrols stopped attackers?




In your opinion would adequate lighting and presence of police patrols stopped attackers?
