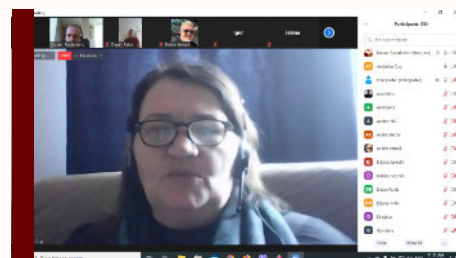
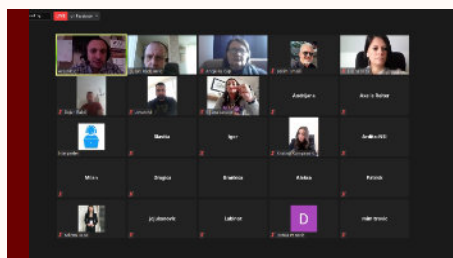
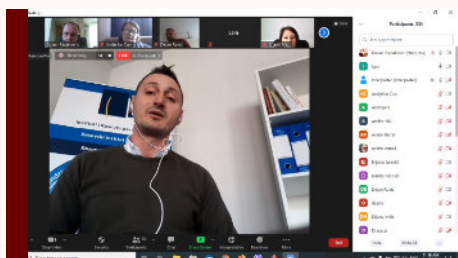
**INVITATION FOR INTERNSHIP**

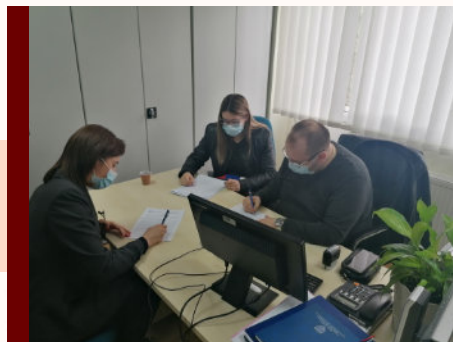
**"PROTECTION OF PROPERTY RIGHTS IN KOSOVO"**

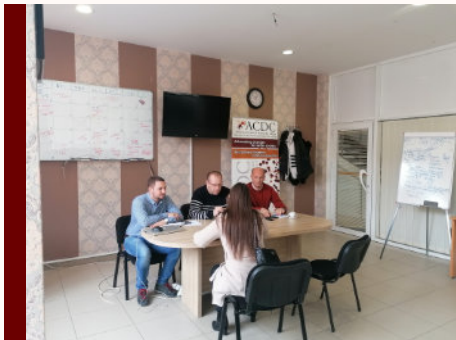
**AUDIT**

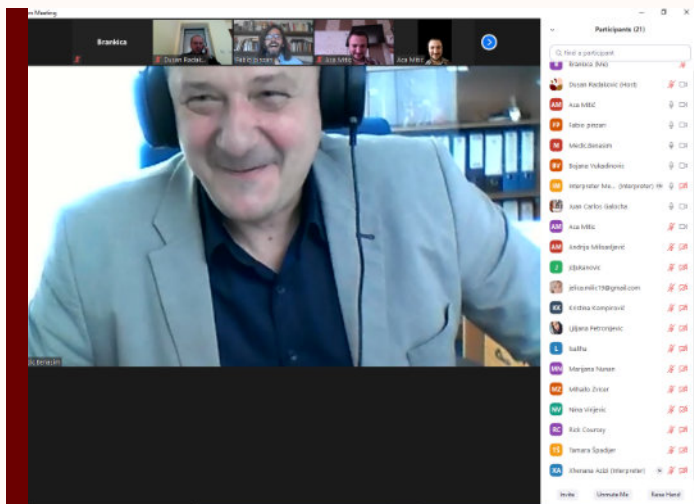
## DEBATE
