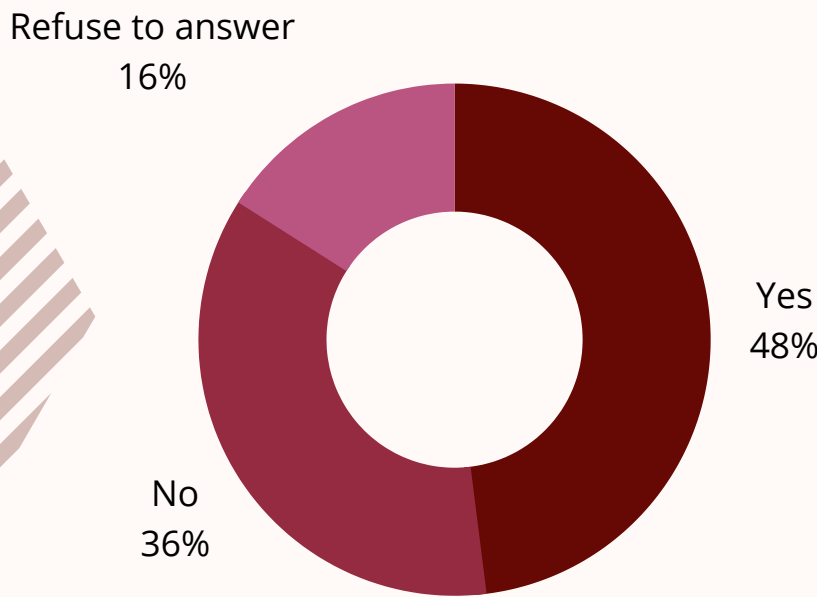

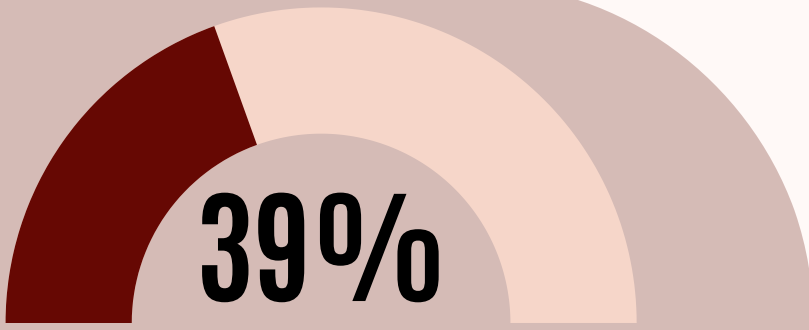
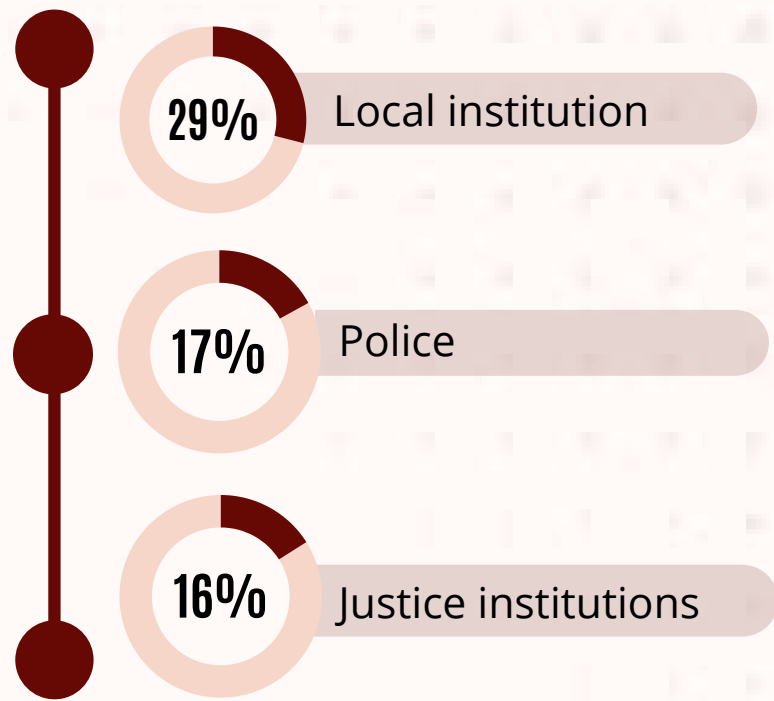


Enhancing Institutional Response to Corruption in northern Kosovo

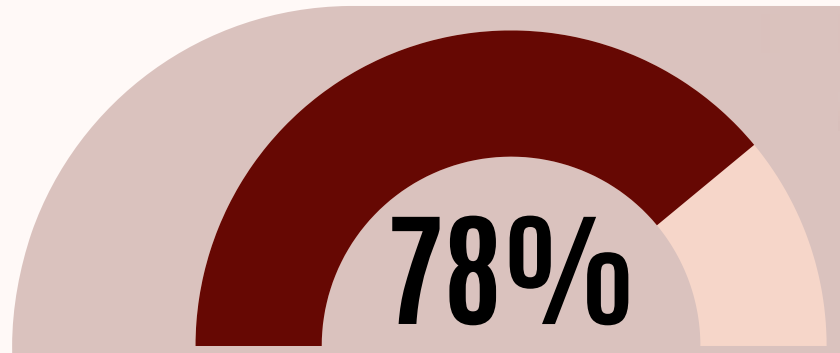
When asked if they encountered corruption in a local institution, 48% of respondents answered YES.



When asked in which institutions, the citizens stated:

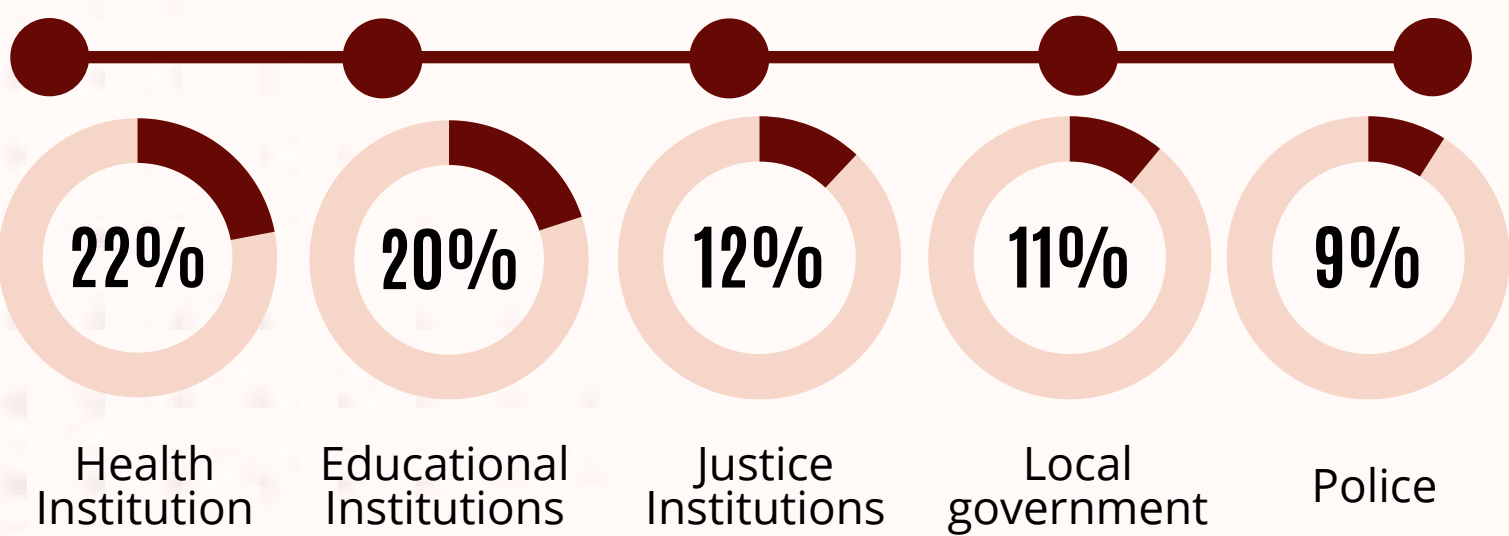


would report corruption if they encountered it in one of the institutions in northern Kosovo



respondents stated that they had never approached the Anti-Corruption Agency

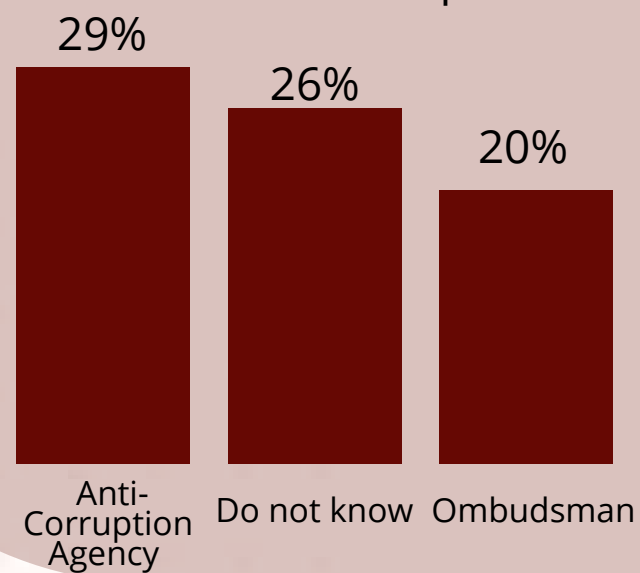
When it comes to the institution in which citizens have the most trust, the highest percentage answered:
