

We have launched a new social media campaign #knowyourrights to ensure that pregnant women and young mothers are aware of their rights in the workplace. Our campaign will provide the basic information to protect and defend your rights during maternity and parental leave.

RESEARCH ON LABOUR RIGHTS

This campaign was launched after conducting research on the labour rights of pregnant women and young mothers, which emphasized the significance of nondiscrimination in labour law and shed light on the perceptions of women regarding the rights and duties of employees. The publication was produced with the financial support of the European Union in the scope of the "Protecting and Promoting Labour Rights of Vulnerable Groups in the Labour Market" project, implemented by Advocacy Training and Resource Center - ATRC in partnership with BIRN Kosovo.
